Club member Robert Bieber, Visiting Research Fellow in War Studies at King's College, London, will talk about Prisoners of England at the end of WWII, via Zoom at 6:30 pm on Monday 12 October 2020. He will cover the national effort to deradicalise former enemies and the remarkable tale of Jewish Army Officers who were notably successful in rehabilitating their former SS enemies at Featherstone, a prisoner war of camp in Northumberland.



Featherstone camp was used for the de-Nazification of former SS officers.
